### **REPORT FROM VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR**

Rusty reviewed his report with Council stating leaf pickup started today until rain hit but it will start back up tomorrow. The paving project is now complete and the total is \$511,821.83 which is around \$13,000.00 under the original \$525,000.00. Boone has been cleaning well #2 all week long and should finish tomorrow. He mentioned that Jim will be with us almost a year and he would like at getting him a raise. Also Rike Plumbing will be starting at the Town Hall next week replacing all the fixtures to touchless.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Angela Veazey with RITA addressed Council regarding how the Village and the Regional Income Tax Agency all come together. She addressed the way penalties (set at federal level) and interest (7% interest) works and how the estimated billing works which is currently stated in the Village ordinance to do. She said this can be changed by vote of Council on if they don't want the estimated billing but that would also change how the Village receives the income. Council can also change penalties and interest, but it would be done on a case by case basis because some people already pay their estimated taxes. Council will be reviewing and making a decision on if a change will happen in the future. Noel Moomey with Rumpke addressed Council regarding individual recycling and also discussed the bins already in place by our Maintenance Barn. He will be getting back to Council on numbers regarding the individual recycling bins. He also reviewed the upcoming 3 year and 5 year renewal proposals to the Village. Kelly made a motion to approve the 5 year contract. Judy second. Roll call. 6 Yea. Motion passed.
