### REPORT FROM VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR

Rusty reviewed his report with Council. The communication modules at the wellfield have been replaced because it wasn't working and the tower wasn't keeping the water capacity where we like it so we had to babysit it for a week but it's now good. The chart recorders at the wastewater plant have been replaced with new as the others were old. He reported on the truck accident that took out the electric boxes and battery backup equipment at 127/725 and the cost for repairs is just over \$22,000.00. Becky has notified insurance companies and the truck driver's insurance should take care of all that. The furnace at the old well field needs replaced and his lowest estimate is \$2,300.00. Debbie made a motion to have the furnace replaced. Jeff second. Roll call. 4 Yea. Motion passed.
